Host City and Event Centre



The JWOC 2019 will take place in the breathtaking surroundings of Lake District Denmark, with 224 sq km of both tecnically and physically demanding continental terrain.

The Event Centre is Jysk Arena in Silkeborg, a major sports arena with easy access from the motorway and great parking conditions. Accommodation will be boarding schools within 1 km of the Event Centre. In addition there are numerous hotels, scout centres, youth hostels and campsites in the area.


Distance from the Event Centre to the city centre of Silkeborg is 2-3 km.



Infrastructure

Travelling to and from Silkeborg is easy. There are 3 international airports within 1.5 hours' drive, and a domestic airport less than 30 mins away with frequent connections from Copenhagen Airport.

A brand new motorway connects Aarhus and Silkeborg in 30 minutes and runs right by the Event Centre.



Each year, OK Pan and Silkeborg OK organise competitions in terrain that is representative of the types of terrain to be used at JWOC2019.

A 4-6 day training camp will be organised at the beginning of August 2018.

In May/June 2019, competitions will be held in both the Aarhus and Silkeborg areas. In this region there are numerous forests with terrain relevant for the JWOC forest distances.


