

Fairness 1 (repetition from Bulletin 4)

REMINDER:

- It is not allowed to use mobile phones, radios, computers or any other <u>communication devices</u> in the Quarantine not even in flight mode. Neither is it allowed to bring in previous orienteering maps of the competition area.
- When staying in the Quarantine, mobile phones must be completely turned off (random checks possible).
- It is allowed to use music players without any built-in connectivity.



Long / Procedures for Quarantine



- Quarantine starts with check-in at the Event Centre (College360).
- All competitors and accompanying team officials must be checked in by the Quarantine close time 10:00.

Long / Transportation

Arrival at the Arena is NOT ALLOWED until 9:30 (note: changed).

Onwards from the 9:35 departure from The Event Centre, the buses to the Pre-Start continues to the Arena, allowing **non-competing athletes and team officials** to go there. Remember to **check in to the Quarantine** - the bus is in the Quarantine zone!

There will be regular transport of team officials from the Pre-start to the Arena by shuttle bus or together with the transport of bags from the Bag Drop.

Sprint / Bringing cars/vans for team transport



To facilitate own transport of teams back from the Arena, **Team Officials** may drive to a Parking area near the Pre-start, provided that

- You register before leaving the Team Officials Meeting
- After parking, you walk to the Pre-start and arrive at the Pre-start before quarantine closes.
- You sign in at the pre-start that you have arrived on time (10.00)

Tomorrow, there are big roadworks just South of Silkeborg on road 52. We recommend that you drive West on the motorway to the junction with road 13 (exit 35) at Pårup, and drive South on road 13 towards the race area. You turn off 13 at Hjøllund. There will be signs to Parking on the road between Vrads and Løve. It is of course not allowed to drive through the embargoed area.


We ask you to show fairness and sportsmanship. Please refer to the fairness rules (Bulletin 4, section 18.0).

Transportation back from Arena

There is an extra return bus at 13:15 - for those with the optional transport ticket.


This bus leaves from the Main Road, approximately 500 m from the Arena. Leave the Arena via the gravel access road beyond the Arena Parking




13.15 Bus departure from Main Road

Long / Start Procedure



• The courses have forking - athletes will be split into even and odd start numbers

Start procedure - Plastic bags


- There are **plastic bags available** for those who wish to protect the map. This is an option it is not mandatory.
- In the start box between minute -2 and -1 there is a box with plastic bags.
- The map is issued, part 1 upside, at the start time
- You are responsible for placing the map in the plastic bag AFTER your start time
- Plastic bag size 297 x 210 mm (A4)
- Map size 277 x 200 mm

Long / Special Features


- The courses cross a heritage railway, shown on the map with symbol 509, Railway.
- There will be no trains running on the day of the Long Distance, and the railway can be freely crossed.
- Competitors can also run along the railway line.

Long / Map Turn-over (repetition from Bulletin 4)

- There is a map turn-over for both women and men at the arena passage.
- The two maps are printed on opposite sides of the same sheet of paper.
- The marked route starts at the last control on the first of the maps.
- On the second map, the marked route is shown with a dashed line.
- The fictitious example shows how it would look on a course with 12 controls, where control 9 is the spectator control.



Long / Forking (repetition from Bulletin 4)




• On both the W20 and M20 courses there is a 'diamond gaffling' as shown in the fictitious example.

Fallen Trees – Forest Areas

Fallen trees are drawn as shown, if they are large and difficult to cross so that they influence runnability.

Length 10-40 m

The symbol used is **410: Vegetation - fight**.



To ensure readability, most trees will be drawn with the same width, and the correct length. The shape of very large canopies are drawn as shown.

Fallen Trees – Forest Areas - Examples

Question 1: Out of bounds areas: Will they be taped out in the forest? **Answer 1:** This is according to ISOM 2017. If OOB is outlined with a solid line, it is taped.

Question 2: Please remind teams that the coaching zone is no picnic place for teams - only max two coaches please. Answer 2: Teams, please respect this.

Question 3: On the image, what are the green lines - lines of brashings/fallen trees/rides or something else and will this be used on the competition map? Answer 3: These lines are not applicable on

the Long distance map.

Question 4: Is cultivated land Out-of-Bounds? Answer 4: No, unless marked with course overprint Out of Bounds (cross hatched)



Question 5: Can we run along the road, and if we can, only at the crossing section or anywhere? Answer 5: Yes, anywhere. You are responsible for keeping an eye on traffic.

Question 6: Is the quarantine indoors or outdoors? Today it was stated that there would be sufficient tents and room for more, implying that it was an outdoor quarantine, but we ended up indoors in a school? Answer 6: Outdoors.

Question 7: We presume that, as quarantine is not closing until 10am, that live results and GPS will not start before then? Answer 7: There will not be live results and GPS tracking before Quarantine is closed.

Question 8: Arriving at arena not before quarantine has closed is to late - We are to late to coach the first runners from the coaching zone at spectator control? Answer 8: You will be allowed to go to the Arena at 9.30. Please respect Fairness rules.

Question 9: What do we do if we don't hear a beep from the control when punching?

Answer 9: If you don't hear a beep, you can use the pinpunch at the control to punch in the boxes on the map.

Question 10: Is last bus time from pre-start to arena too late ? Answer 10: Also transport after 1.30.

Question 11: Start nos., same process as today? Took too much time today.

Answer 11: They will be issued in the same way as today.

Question 12: Private transport - How long walk? Answer 12: Maximum 15 minutes

Question 13: Can we then drive own cars to arena? Answer 13: Yes, you drive your own car.

Question 14: Lunch in quarantine? Answer 14: No, only at the arena.

Question 15: Can we take something from breakfast to have as lunch? Answer 15: Unfortunately, no.

Question 16: Map change: on first part of map, finish circle in B4 - is it like that on the map? Answer 16: It will be like that on the map tomorrow - remember there is a map on both sides.

Question 17: Running close to finish line - how far away? Can have SIAC switched off in error. Answer 17: That will not be a problem tomorrow.

Question 18: Can all coaches see the map of travel to pre-start? Answer 18: Yes. You can see the route to the signposting only, not the actual Parking location.
