Review of yesterday's LONG Race

Regrettably, two SI AIR+ cards lost the touch free function during the race. Both cards went successfully through battery and SIAC tests at the Pre-start before the race.

As a consequence, the two competitors had to do "touch based" punching for the remainder of the course, and the finish times for the two competitors were registered by the back-up timing system.

Back-up functionality for punching as well as for timekeeping was in place. The organisers have decided to continue with the current setup.

Review of yesterday's LONG Race

In the provisional results, Veronika Kalinina, RUS - based on her manual time - was placed second, 1 second slower than Ida Haapala, FIN. Following a protest from RUS, concerning the precision of the finish time, the Jury (Christine Brown AUS, Kalle Dalin, SWE, and Szava Zsigmond HUN) made the decision to adjust Ida Haapala's time to 53:46, the same time as Veronika Kalinina.

The decision was based on an analysis of the times recorded by the primary and the back-up timing systems. The Jury decided that it cannot be proven that the time of the back-up timing system is the same as that of the primary system. Thus, both competitors' times are now based on the back-up timing system.

Review of yesterday's LONG Race

Regarding the prestart-start procedure, we hope that all are happy with the setup. We made additional improvements in handling the number bibs compared with what was announced at Sunday's TOM.



Middle Qualification / Procedures for Quarantine

Middle Qualification and Finals / Bringing cars/vans for team transport



To facilitate own transport of teams back from the Arena, **Team** Officials may drive to the Middle Distance Arena Parking, provided that

- You register before leaving the Team Officials Meeting, unless already registered
- After parking, you walk to the Pre-start follow marking to Pre-start and arrive at the pre-start before quarantine closes.
- You sign in at the pre-start that you have arrived on time (10.00 for Qualification, 9.00 for the Finals)

We ask you to show fairness and sportsmanship. Please refer to the fairness rules (Bulletin 4, section 18.0).

Middle Qualification / Map change



• There is a map turnover for all courses.

- The two parts are NOT printed on the same side.
- This is a change compared to what is stated in Bulletin 4.

Start procedure - Plastic bags

- There are plastic bags available for those who wish to protect the map. This is an option - it is not mandatory.
- Plastic bags are available both for the Qualification and for the Finals.
- In the start box between minute -2 and -1 there is a box with plastic bags.
- The map is issued, **part 1 upside**, at the start time
- You are responsible for placing the map in the plastic bag AFTER your start time
- Plastic bag size 297 x 210 mm (A4)
- Map sizes are
 - 180 x 198 mm (qualification)
 - 182 x 240 mm (finals)

Sheep




- After the publication of Bulletin 4, a flock of 40 sheep was released in a fenced area.

- Please show consideration for the animals.
- They normally remain calm and stay together as a flock.



Middle Qualification / Mapping / Special Features

- There is a mandatory road crossing point and the courses have a control immediately before the crossing point.
- It is mandatory to follow the white tape marking to the crossing point. The crossing will be shown on the map as in this example.
- Officials manning the crossing will help competitors look out for traffic. They are not allowed to stop the traffic, and it is the competitor's own responsibility to cross the road safely.





QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Question 1: In the Long meeting, it was stated that the symbol on the map for 'long lines of brashings' (or similar) was not to be used, but this was not the case (see sample of map around women's 3rd control attached). Will this or any other non-standard symbol be used on the middle maps in the next two days? **Answer 1:** Sorry about the mistaken info about this symbol not being used on the Long distance. The symbol is the same as is used for large fallen trees: ISOM 2017 410 Fight. The symbol may also be used for other thick vegetation than fallen trees.



Question 2: Will plastic bags be provided again and, if so, what will be the bag size?

Answer 2: Plastic bags will be provided for the Qualification and the Finals. The bag size is A4 (210 x 297 mm)

Question 3: Will part 1 be on the left of the paper? Answer 3: No. As previously mentioned, there will be a map turnover instead.

Question 4: Will it just be the relevant control circle/number on both sides at the map switch or something else? Answer 4: The last control on part 1 will be repeated on part 2

Question 5: Will quarantine be indoors or outdoors? Answer 5: The quarantine is outdoors

Question 6: Is white and green on competition maps drawn in similar style as on model map? Answer 6: Yes, the mapping style is identical on the model map and the competition map.

Question 7: The bracken was not on the map at Model Event today. Will it be the same in the Middle races? Answer 7: The same mapping style applies to the competition maps. It has been rainy and warm recently, and the vegetation grows fast.

Question 8: On Model Event today the flag on control 42 was placed in the pit. For fairness, we think that the flag should be on the side instead.

What do the organizers think about fairness and flags in pits? Answer 8: We agree that control flags should not be placed in pits. It was a mistake at the Model Event.

Question 9: Will GPS units be handed out before -11 tomorrow? **Answer 9:** For the Qualification and the Finals we shall ensure that the procedure described in Bulletin 4 is followed.

Question 10: Are the gates open tomorrow? Answer 10: The gates are not open. You open them yourself, and they are self-closing.

Question 11: Is it possible to run in the JWOC tour tomorrow Answer 11: Unfortunately not.

Question 12: Is parking at the Arena Parking before closure of Quarantine allowed? Answer 12: Yes, and then proceed directly to the pre-start on foot.


Question 13: Will there be a warm-up map - and is there enough space for warm-up?

Answer 13: There will not be a warm-up map - but enough space for warm-up. This applies both for Qualification and Finals.

Question 14: Is it the same pre-start for Qualification and Finals? Can we leave the tent there? Answer 14: We are not prepared to provide additional information about this.

Question 15: An athlete did a battery check at the pre-start and got a series of beeps. Was the SIAC faulty? Answer 15: A series of beeps means that the SIAC is OK, but we will change the procedure for tomorrow, so that the SIAC is changed in that case.
